_____ Sees Revelation as a description of spiritual conflict and not of physical experience.

_____ Believes that Revelation is referring to the time of the Apostle John.

There are four categories of "eschatology" which is the study of _____ times theology:

_____ Jesus will physically return to earth (The Second Coming) before the Millennium which is a literal thousand year golden age of peace.

_____ An interpretation of chapter 20 that believes Christ will return after the thousand year Millennium.

_____ The Rapture happens before the seven year Tribulation period.

_____ The Rapture happens after the seven year Tribulation period.
